


Setting Standards

- Generic Automatic Weather Station (AWS) Tender Specifications (Instruments and Observing Methods (IOM) Report No. 136) was published in May 2022, which became the basis of GBON specifications and SOFF implementation.
- Potential Phase 2
 - Add Upper Air
 - Enhance User Experience Web
