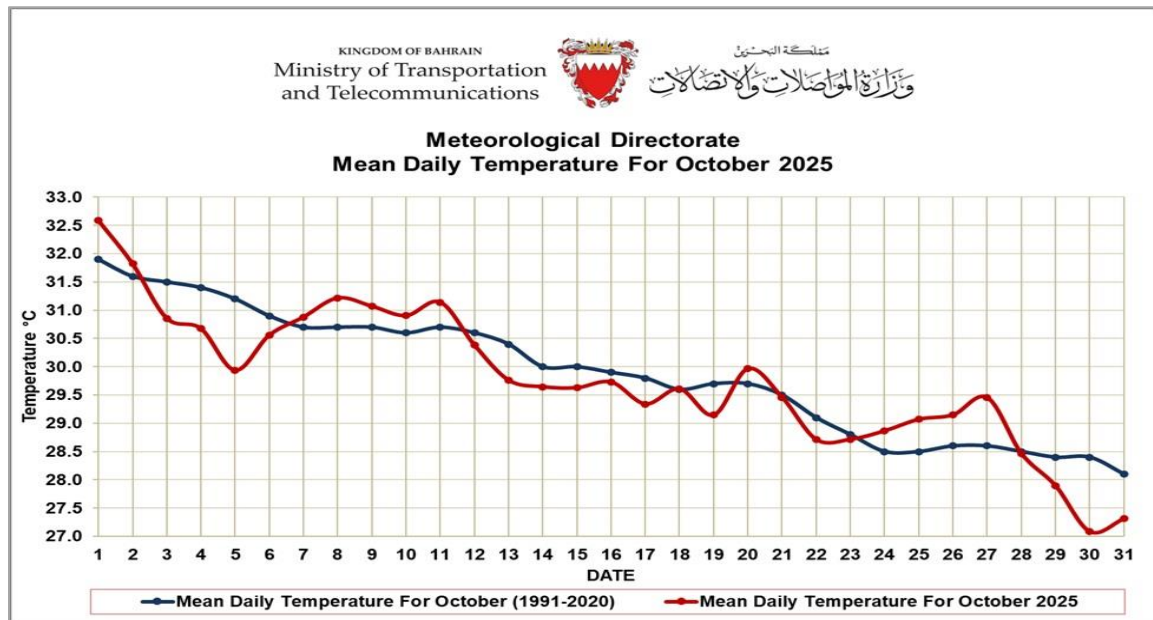


Meteorological Directorate

Monthly Weather Summary – OCTOBER 2025

October 2025 was slightly cooler than normal in temperatures with below-average relative humidities.



The mean temperature of the month was 29.8°C which is 0.1°C below the long-term normal for October. Note that the highest mean monthly temperature for October was 32.1°C recorded in 2019.

The mean maximum temperature of the month was 33.1°C which is 0.9°C below the long-term normal. Note that the highest mean monthly maximum temperature for October was 35.9°C recorded in 2019.

During the month, Bahrain had 4 days with maximum temperatures exceeding 35°C. The highest temperature recorded during the month was 35.6°C which occurred on the 1st October 2025 at Bahrain International Airport. Note that the highest temperature recorded for October at Bahrain International Airport was 42.8°C, which occurred on the 1st October 2001.

The highest temperature recorded in the month at the Durrat Al Bahrain was 39.4°C recorded on the 1st October, and it was recorded 38.4°C at the University of Bahrain on the same day.

The mean minimum temperature of the month was 26.9°C which is 0.5°C above the long-term normal. Note that the highest mean monthly minimum temperature for October was 29.6°C recorded in 2019.

The lowest temperature recorded was 24.6°C on 31st October at Bahrain International Airport but was recorded 19.2°C on the 26th October at the Rashid Equestrian & Horseracing Club.

The mean relative humidity for October was 59% whereas the mean maximum relative humidity was 75%, and the mean minimum relative humidity was 40%. The maximum relative humidity was 92% recorded on the 16th October, and the minimum relative humidity was 13% recorded on the 4th October.

No precipitation was reported in October. Note that the long-term mean total precipitation for October is 0.9 mm, and the highest monthly rainfall recorded during October at Bahrain International Airport was 19.9 mm which occurred in 2018.
