


WMO El Niño/La Niña Update

NOVEMBER 2025

ESTIMATED ENSO PROBABILITIES FOR DECEMBER-FEBRUARY 2025/2026



- As of mid-November, borderline La Niña conditions have been present across the tropical Pacific.
- Model predictions and expert assessment indicate about 55 % chance that the cooler than normal equatorial Pacific will remain at La Niña levels during the period December 2025 through February 2026.
- The chance of a return to ENSO-neutral conditions is estimated at 45% for December-February 2025/2026.
- The likelihood of El Niño conditions emerging during the forecast period is negligible.
 - Information on ENSO should be combined with other regionally and locally relevant factors in order to anticipate its effects on regional climates.
