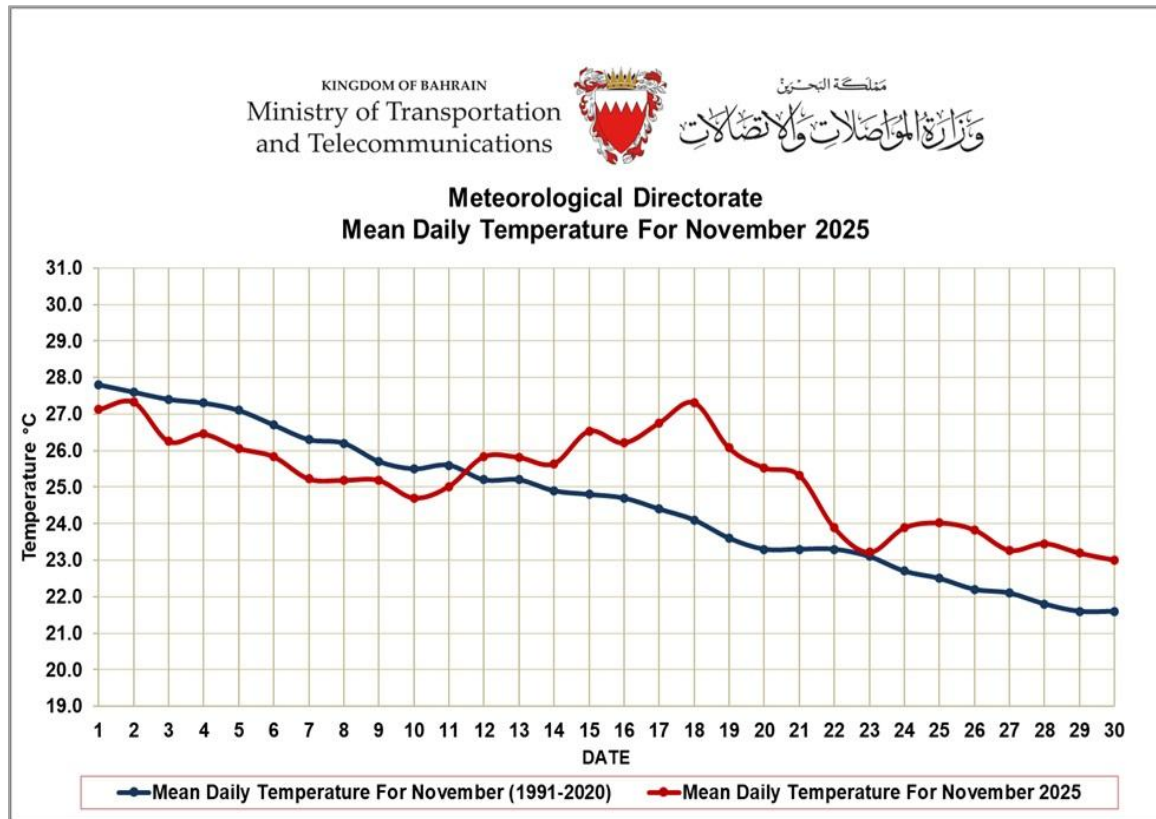


Meteorological Directorate

Monthly Weather Summary – NOVEMBER 2025

November 2025 was slightly warmer than normal in temperatures with below-average relative humidities.



The mean temperature of the month was 25.2°C which is 0.6°C above the long-term normal for November. Note that the highest mean monthly temperature for November was 27.4°C recorded in 2022.

The mean maximum temperature of the month was 28.0°C which is the same as the long-term normal. Note that the highest mean monthly maximum temperature for November was 30.8°C recorded in 2022.

Meteorological Directorate

During the month, Bahrain had 3 days with maximum temperatures exceeding 30°C. The highest temperature recorded during the month was 30.6°C which occurred on the 2nd November 2025 at Bahrain International Airport. Note that the highest temperature recorded for November at Bahrain International Airport was 37.2°C, which occurred on the 1st November 1999.

The highest temperature recorded in the month at the Durrat Al Bahrain was 32.4°C recorded on the 2nd November, and it was recorded 32.2°C at the Rashid Equestrian & Horseracing Club on the 15th November.

The mean minimum temperature of the month was 22.6°C which is 1.0°C above the long-term normal. Note that the highest mean monthly minimum temperature for November was 24.7°C recorded in 2022.

The lowest temperature recorded was 19.9°C on 28th November at Bahrain International Airport but was recorded 12.7°C on the 27th November at the Rashid Equestrian & Horseracing Club.

The mean relative humidity for November was 61% whereas the mean maximum relative humidity was 77%, and the mean minimum relative humidity was 45%. The maximum relative humidity was 94% recorded on the 24th November, and the minimum relative humidity was 22% recorded on the 9th and 27th November.

No precipitation was reported in November. Note that the long-term mean total precipitation for November is 16.8 mm, the highest monthly rainfall recorded during November at Bahrain International Airport was 146.8 mm which occurred in 1940, and the highest daily rainfall recorded during November at Bahrain International Airport was 57.6 mm which occurred on the 19th November 2000.
