




Meteorological Directorate

Monthly Weather Summary – FEBRUARY 2026

February 2026 was warmer than normal in Bahrain, ranking as the second-warmest February on record for mean temperature.

Precipitation was below average. Relative humidity was generally low, with mean and mean minimum values below normal and mean maximum humidity slightly above normal.



The average temperature for the month was 21.4°C, which is 3.0°C higher than the long-term February normal, and this goes on record as the second-highest mean temperature for February since 1902. Note that the highest mean monthly temperature for February was 21.5°C, recorded in 1963.

The month's mean maximum temperature reached 25.6°C, which is 3.6°C above the long-term normal, and this goes on record as the highest mean maximum temperature for February since 1946. The old record for February was 25.2°C recorded in 1963.

The highest temperature recorded during the month was 31.2°C, which occurred on 14th February 2026 at Bahrain International Airport. It is noteworthy that the highest temperature recorded for February at Bahrain International Airport remains 34.7°C, observed on 22nd February 1973.

At the Rashid Equestrian & Horseracing Club, the maximum temperature recorded during the month was 33.5°C on 14th February, while the University of Bahrain registered a temperature of 32.7°C on the same date.

The average minimum temperature for the month was 18.4°C, which is 3.0°C above the long-term February normal, and this goes on record as the highest mean minimum temperature for February since 1946. The old record for February was 18.3°C recorded in 1963.

The minimum temperature for the month was 16.3°C, recorded on 3rd February at Bahrain International Airport. However, a lower minimum of 11.8°C was registered on 23rd February at the Rashid Equestrian & Horseracing Club, representing the lowest temperature during the month across all stations.

Note that the lowest temperature recorded at Bahrain International Airport for February was 7.2°C, which occurred on 11th February 1949 and 8th February 1950.

The mean monthly relative humidity was 65%. This was 2% below the long-term normal. The mean maximum was 86%, which is 4% above the long-term normal. The mean minimum was 40%, which is 9% below the long-term normal. The absolute maximum was 100% recorded on the 9th, 10th and 19th February. The absolute minimum was 15% recorded on the 24th February.

A total of 0.6 mm of precipitation was reported in February 2026 at Bahrain International Airport. Note that the long-term mean total precipitation for February is 13.0 mm, the highest monthly rainfall recorded during February at Bahrain International Airport was 106.8 mm, which occurred in 1988, and the highest daily rainfall recorded during February at Bahrain International Airport was 40.9 mm, which occurred on the 24th February 1988.

The total monthly precipitation recorded for February 2026 at the King Fahad Causeway was 2.6 mm, whereas the total precipitation at the University of Bahrain was 1.2 mm, at Rashid Equestrian & Horseracing Club was 0.8 mm, at Sitra Island was 0.8 mm and at Durrat Al Bahrain was 0.6 mm.
