Early Warnings for All (EW4All) in RA VI

Strengthening Regional Cooperation for Better Early Warning Services

- EW4All aims to ensure that everyone is protected by effective multi-hazard early warning systems.
- Capacity development and regional cooperation are key pillars of implementation.
- WMO Regional Association VI (RA VI) brings together 50 Members with diverse levels of technical and institutional capacity.
- Advancing together requires stronger mechanisms for knowledge sharing, peer learning, and mutual support.

No Member should be left behind in strengthening early warning capabilities

Challenge: Uneven Capacities Across the Region

Areas where needs may exist:

- Technical expertise and specialized knowledge, training and professional development opportunities
- Observation, forecasting and IT infrastructure
- Service delivery
- Cooperation opportunities for sub-regional/bilateral etc. initiatives
- Development and implementation of standards, procedures, strategies

At the same time:

- Many NMHSs possess valuable expertise, experience and resources.
- New opportunities for cooperation remain difficult to identify.

The region already has significant expertise—the challenge is connecting needs with available support

From Need to Action - Responding to the RA VI EW4All Road Map

RA VI Support Exchange Platform

- Implements deliverable and action 3.2 included in the [WMO Early Warnings for All Road Map for RA VI](#): Develop twinning activities between NMHSs to improve EWS-related competencies.
- Promotes practical exchange and peer-to-peer support among Members.
- Aims to strengthen solidarity and collective progress across RA VI.
- Creates a transparent mechanism to identify needs and support opportunities.
- Requested by the RA VI Management Group and developed by the RA VI High-Level Task Team for EW4All and ROE.

RA VI Support Exchange Platform - A Peer-to-Peer Collaboration Mechanism

Purpose:

- Submit requests for support.
- Offer expertise, training, tools, or assistance.
- Connect directly with other Members.
- Develop practical cooperation activities.

Guiding Principles:

- Voluntary participation.
- No-cost collaboration among Members.
- Peer-to-peer approach.
- Transparent and efficient matching process.
- Focus on capacity development and operational improvement support.

Pilot Phase

Initial access provided to:

- Permanent Representatives
- Hydrological Advisors
- Agency Approvers

Call to Action:

- Explore the platform.
- Submit requests and opportunities.
- Help strengthen early warning capacities across the region.

Objectives of the Pilot:

- Test functionality and matching processes.
- Encourage active participation by Members.
- Identify opportunities for improvement.
- Build a culture of collaboration and mutual support across RA VI.
