
From that moment JMD is knocking all doors and look for all ways to work with all local national associations and international organizations especially the WMO on early warning system.

where the experiences that were Provided by the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) and advices, had a major role in bringing the point of views closer to the success of the project between the three parties.






### METEOROLOGICAL JIP –PROJECT ORGANIZATION JORDAN –PALESTIN –ISRAEL



It was agreed between the meteorological departments of the three countries to exchange Data (climatic data, radar images, satellites, automatic observation stations and numerical model data), where the infrastructure was prepared. Therefore, soon the last steps will be completed with the exchange of data, where a common database will be created that will transcribe and display the data collected for the three parties and will be of great use in calibration operations and adjusting products, whether radar or numerical models used to launch warnings.









In addition of that, it was agreed to work on capacities building of the three countries with WMO support in the field of flash flood forecasting and work to build a joint electronic operation center for flood forecasting.







JMD is making all its efforts to make this project a success and looking forward to expand the project to include not only flash floods,

but other phenomena such as **Dust Storms** which is an interest of JMD that also affect the countries.



We always strive and believe, as are all members of the World Meteorological Organization WMO, that every human being deserves to receive a warning of severe weather phenomena in a timely manner to achieve the goal of our existence, which is to contribute to the protection of lives and property.
